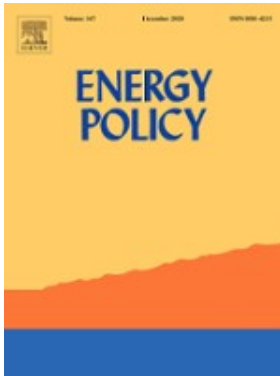

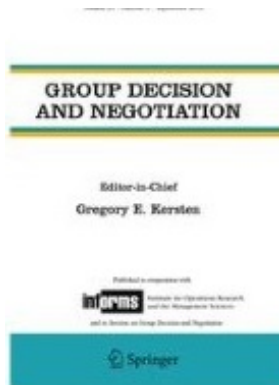

**Abstract**  
The main objective of research focuses on the individual factors leading to coronavirus mortality. Numerous studies have shown that the age of the population is the dominant factor explaining mortality. Other parameters such as social gender, comorbidity, ethnicity and identity.
